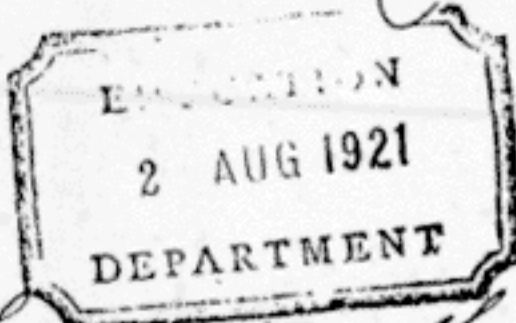

Sir

I submit a further report on the application for a school at Ringwood North. Please note that there are two plans marked respectively I and II. The former is my plan, the latter a rough one prepared by Mr Williams. On the latter which was handed to the surveyor, there were two rough rectangles in blue pencil when he received it. (I have since added a cross to show the site selected and to show that it agrees with the position on my plan) It must be remembered that when the surveyor received the rough plan there was no cross on it. He therefore concluded that the site was in Williams Road and was quite justified in doing so. — In my report, however, I state that the site inspected and approved of by all the people is marked by a blue cross. See plan marked I <sup>and my report.</sup> This site is in Oban Road. It has been surveyed & arranged. The site in Williams Road is the one the people had in mind first, but they decided on the Oban Road site on the day of my visit. The site in Williams Road would cost a great deal more. The land in Oban Road has a fall to the West but the slope is not such as to be a serious drawback. It will facilitate drainage.
